Show Entries: Open to all breeds of horses and levels. Entries competing on **AQHA horses** need to submit copies of breeding registration and AQHA membership cards for owner and riders. All entries need an entry form, copy of coggins, Liability release, and fees. One entry form per horse/rider combination. Entries may be entered online https://www.striderpro.com/a/1b_uhSrVEUGQqybi6lR-bQ Closing date for entries is July 1, 2024. Any entries received, based on availability, will incur a \$25 late fee.

Clinic Entry: Open to all breeds of horses and levels. Each horse/rider combination will receive a 45 minute time slot. Ten (10) individual lessons will be available. A waitlist will be started once all slots are filled. Times will be distributed 3 days prior to the clinic. Auditors will be allowed and encouraged, \$30 due upon entry of the facility.

Stalls: Available Friday July 19, 2024. \$40/night shavings included in the stalls.

Lodging: Two camper hookups are available for \$10/day. If no electric is needed, you may stay in your trailer for no fee. Please notify the show manager if you choose this option. Nearby hotels can be found in Lexington, VA

Rings: 20m x 60m dressage ring and warm up ring

Schooling: Will be allowed Friday July 12, 2024 after 2pm. No schooling allowed in the show ring on July 13, 2024. Warm up ring will be available for your use at any time.

Awards: Classes will be pinned through Sixth place.

Correct tack and attire will be required as defined by USEF/WDAA rules. Please see the rule book for legal appointments. You can find a copy of the rules [here](#). One horse per every three horses in a class will have bit/tack checked. Anyone found in violation of the rules will forfeit the ride and score earned.

Ride times will be emailed and posted online. Classes will not run in order.

Level 3, 4, and 5 are available as test of choice. If you would like to ride more than 1 test at these levels, please notify the show manager before entering.

ANN JUDGE

Ann Judge, a Purdue University graduate, is from Denver, Colorado, U.S.A., where she has owned and operated a show horse training facility since 1985. Ann trains Arabians and Half-Arabians and has won national awards in several divisions. Ann has served as a judge since 1993 and holds cards in USEF Arabian, Western Dressage, Morgan, Western/Stock Seat, ; PtHA (Pinto Horse Association); NRCHA (National Reined Cow Horse) and AMHA (American Miniature Horse Association). Ann has judged the U.S. Arabian National Championships(7 times), the Pinto World(7 times) the U.S. Arabian Youth Nationals(3 times), the AMHA World Show(4 times) the South African Arabian Nationals, the Canadian Pinto National Championships, the Australian Miniature National Championships, and the Canadian Miniature Horse National Championships.

Ann was named APAHA Horsewoman of the Year in 2014, 2016, and 2018, and inducted into the APAHA Hall of Fame in 2020. In 2015 she was inducted into the Pinto Judges Hall of Fame and in 2018 she was named again to the Pinto Hall of Fame as Horsewoman of the Year.

When not showing or judging horses, Ann enjoys her job during the NFL football season as rider of “Thunder”, the Denver Broncos’ mascot, and loves the thrill of riding down the field to the roar of a crowd of 75,000 fans each time the team scores!
