Join clinician and USEF 'S' judge, Alison Head, for an educational day of test riding with special focus on the new 2019 USEF dressage tests. Riders will be scored on their test of choice followed by a mini-lesson and an opportunity to re-ride the test. Ride sessions are ~30 minutes each, and riders will receive their scored tests. Discussions will cover the pyramid of training, movements and accuracy, common problem areas, how to benefit from collective marks, and more. Auditor seating is plentiful and audience participation is encouraged.

Alison Head has earned her USDF bronze, silver, and gold medals and bronze and silver freestyle bars. She has trained multiple horses to the Grand Prix level, and trained multiple students to compete into the FEI levels. She has a 5-star rating on centerlinescores.com.

- All USDF, USEF, and FEI tests (Introductory through Grand Prix) are welcome.
- Second ride session permitted if space available.
- The first scored ride of each session will count toward IEO Year-end Awards.

Riders:

Ride-A-Test entry, per ride - \$60 IEO non-member rider fee, per day - \$20 Stall with 2 bags shavings (May 4 or May 4&5) - \$50 Additional bags of shavings - \$7 each

Auditors:

Day audit - \$25

- Lunch and refreshments are included with both rider and auditor pre-registration. Vegetarian options included. Walk-in auditors are welcome, but please bring your own lunch. Plenty of bleacher seating is provided.
- Rider refunds allowed minus a \$15 office fee only if the ride can be filled from a waiting list. No auditor refunds.
- A current Coggins dated within one year of May 4, 2019 must be provided for the horse ridden in the event.
- Signed waivers of liability forms are required by both IEO and USDF; riders under 18 must have both forms signed by a parent or legal guardian.
- All riders, while mounted, must wear helmets that meet or exceed ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use.
- This event is approved for USDF University credit (program #103134, maximum 1.0 credit). Participant must be a current USDF member and pay a \$5 fee. USDF accredited this program for its educational content. USDF is not responsible for the date, location, organization, or presentation of this program or for any other circumstances relevant to this program.
