Pre-Intro and Intro will be in a 20x40 indoor or outdoor arena (you can request indoor)

Training level will be in 20x60 outdoor arena (you can request 20x40 indoor arena)

Cool ribbons and prizes! In the danish system you get the ribbon you earned at your level - multiple ribbons per zone

If you are trailering with someone, please let us know. Classes will be run out of order except the open division. You may ride one or both days. Each rider is limited to two tests, but horses may do up to 5 tests per day.

We love dogs, but no dogs are allowed on the property. Warm-up will be either on grass or in the indoor or outdoor arena. Your coach may coach you from E or B or use an electronic device.

How it works!

We are running the same show two days in a row to accommodate as many riders as possible. You can choose to ride one day or both days. You have options! You can choose to ride your test in the 20x40 indoor arena or 20x60 outdoor arena. All tests except pre-intro will be offered inside or out.

You may ride in English, western tack or ride bareback... YES bareback. You may ride bitless.

You pick your class, day(s), and arena. We will group riders accordingly for high score awards, but your tests will use the danish scoring system which means you will leave with your test and the placing and ribbon your test qualifies for. (For example, if you received a 68 or above, you'll leave with a blue ribbon in the open division, but a 66 or above qualifies for blue in the lesson horse division.

You may dress casually, formally, or dress in chicken attire. Chicken attired riders compete for best chicken attire awards per division. Decorate your horse in chicken attire and compete for best decorated horse awards. Lesson horses ridden by several riders will have a team horse decoration award.

If you are trailering with friends, please let us know so we can group your rides together.

Warm-up: Small groups of four or less will warm up in the arena they are showing in, but the opposite ring will be open for those who like a longer warmup time.

Concessions: You may have your coach talk you through your test, call your test, or walk with you during your test in the chicken division. You may request private warm-up in the ring before your ride if your horse can't handle warming up with others. You can cry. You may bring your horses' emotional support horse with them to stand ringside. No dogs.

Ribbon zones: think of it as being graded on a curve. You can your instructor can ride the same test and both get a second place when you receive a qualifying score!


