COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS

1. This show will be conducted and judged in accordance with the United States Rules for Working Equitation, Revision 4. The rules can be found at www.usawe.org/rules.
2. ASTM/SEI approved headgear required for all competitors.
3. Rider's choice of attire should be neat and presentable. Boots and/or half-chaps, breeches or western jeans, collared shirts are permitted. Polos are fine; jackets not required.
4. Refer to US Rules for Working Equitation for complete Tack Rules.
5. The competition number must be displayed while the horse is under saddle.
6. A horse may be entered twice in a competition if ridden by two different riders and in different levels. Exceptions are at the discretion of the show management.
7. Frying Pan Farm Park requires a current **Certificate of Health for all out-of-state horses coming on the property**. You must show this Certificate and a current Coggins when you check in.

- Registration & Payment will be through <https://www.striderpro.com/>.
- No refunds after closing date.
- If the class has filled, you will see a "Wait List" option in the Strider program.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

- Complete entry and pay on Striderpro.com.
- Print and sign the NOVAWE & Frying Pan Liability Releases; bring both to the event.
- Email copy of the negative Coggins test dated within one year of the end of the show to the event secretary.
- Onsite Stabling is offered for Friday and Saturday.
- If you are stabling, choose and pay for the stabling options when you register in Striderpro.com.

GENERAL INFORMATION

LOCATION OF COMPETITION:

- The show will be held in the indoor arena at Frying Pan Farm Park (FPFP).
- Warm up will be in the outdoor arena beside the indoor arena.
- If there is not an organized event in the upper and lower rings, you can warm up in those rings as well.
- The grounds are open for hacking, but please do not school the cross-country fences.

RIDE TIMES: In Working Equitation, all rides are by "Order of Go".

- Approximate Dressage Ride times will be emailed to the competitors.
- Competitors are advised to recheck the day sheet upon arrival as last-minute changes to the schedule may have been made.
- Riders may walk the course at designated times before the EOH Trial and the Speed Trial.

RIBBONS/PRIZES

- Ribbons will be awarded from 1st to 6th place in each trial of each level.
- Overall Ribbons: Champion & Reserve Champion will be awarded for Levels 1-2 provided there are at least two riders in that level.
- Fastest Overall Time in Speed Ribbon awarded.
- NOVAWE members' Dressage & EOH scores will count towards NOVAWE's Year-End Awards Program.
- NOVAWE High Score Ribbons awarded in Dressage and EOH (for NOVAWE members).
- Prizes donated by NOVAWE Business Members, *Another Turn Tack and Apparel* and *Professional Horse Services*.

STABLING ON SITE DETAILS

- Stalls are 10 x 12 with rubber mats. Use shavings to bed your stall.
- Emergency contact information must be prominently displayed on all stalls housing an animal, including both cell phone and local contact information.
- Use only the stall that you are assigned.
- There is a wheelbarrow available for use in the barn, but please use your own manure fork.
- Water for horses available for those stabling onsite.
- Bring your own hay, buckets, and feed.
- Stabling Fee includes a onetime stall cleaning fee of \$15.
 - Stabling on Saturday: Stall Cleaning Fee + One Day Stall Use = \$35.
 - Stabling on Friday and Saturday: Stall Cleaning Fee + Two Day Stall Use = \$55.
 - You will NOT be required to strip the stall when you leave but are encouraged to put soiled bedding in manure pit by Barn 1 during the day.
- Friday Arrival: Friday, Nov 5, 2021 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm or contact Biddie Lowry for arranged time.
- Saturday Arrival: After 7:00 am on Saturday, Nov 6, 2021
- Departure: Saturday, Nov 6, 2021 by 7:00 pm
- There is no overnight security. The gates to the park will appear to be closed to the passerby, but you still have access in and out.
- Restrooms are in the Indoor Building.
- There are no hookups for overnight trailers.

SHOWING FROM TRAILER DETAILS

- There is no charge to show from your trailer.
- If showing from your trailer, please take your manure and loose hay home with you or place in concrete manure pit before you leave.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Dogs and pets must be leashed and under control of the owner while on park property.
- Bring your own food and water.
- Alcohol beverages are prohibited in the Park.
- Show is limited to 18 riders.
- **Change Policy:** Changes to level, rider, or horse are not permitted.
- **Refund Policy:** No refunds after Closing Date.

- No lunging in the warmup arena beside the Indoor. If you need to lunge you horse, use one of the other arenas and be mindful of other riders around you.
- Scratch or Withdraw before the Closing Date and receive entry fee minus \$10 Office Fee.
