Leadline - For riders 7yrs and under. Judged on their basic position in the saddle.

Pre Short Stirrups Walk- 10yrs and under. Walk Trot Only. Division held if enough entries

Short Stirrup Hunter- Open to riders 12 years and under. Fences are approximately 18 inches. Courses may be trotted Walk and trot only in hack class. Canter is optional over fences.

Long Stirrup Hunter- Open to riders 13 years and older. Fences are approximately 18 inches. Courses may be trotted Walk and trot only in hack class. Canter is optional over fences.

Student Eq- Open to riders in their first or second year of showing over fences 2 feet or higher. Judged on equitation. Courses may be trotted. Fences are approximately 2 feet.

Pony Pleasure - Open to ponies ridden by Juniors. This division may be combined with the Horse Pleasure division.

Horse Pleasure- Open to all horses. This division may be combined with the Pony Pleasure division.

Low Hunter- Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fences are approximately 2 feet.

Limit Hunter- Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Fences are approximately 2'3 feet.

Green Hunters- Open to horses in their 1st or 2nd year of showing over fences 2'6" or higher. Riders have a choice between fences that are approximately 2'6 feet or 2'9 feet.

Children/Adult Hunter U/S, O/F, O/F 2'6, 2'9- Open to horses ridden by juniors or amateurs. Riders have a choice between fences that are approximately 2'6 feet or 2'9 feet.

Open Hunter - Open to horses and ponies. No restrictions on riders. Riders have a choice between fences that are approximately 2'6 feet or 2'9 feet.



Additional Information

- Unjudged trips allowed at class fee and then, only done after a judged trip, if any, in the same class.
- All hunter classes judged on performance, including way of going, jumping style, and soundness. Manners and suitability emphasized in pony children's and adult amateur division.
- Warm Up: Not Judged. A horse/rider combination may participate in one or more warm-up class(es) at each show at management's discretion. Warm up classes may be discontinued at any time. Riders must let the starter know upon entering the ring if the round is a warm-up.
- Frying Pan Park, Staff and Volunteers will not be held responsible for accident, loss, injuries to exhibitors, spectators or animals, or damage to equipment of any kind.
- Dress is casual. (Boots and breeches, polo shirt) and neat, clean clothing. Appropriate heeled boots and helmets are required.
- SEI certified helmet required when mounted.
- No poor sportsmanship or bad conduct will be tolerated by any participant or spectator.
- Show management has the right to combine or cancel any classes/divisions if there are less than 3 entries.
- Age of rider is determined "as of" January 1, 2025.
- The judge has the authority to excuse any horse from a class due to lameness OR safety concerns.
- The Judges and/or Show Managers decision is FINAL.
- The use of any illegal equipment (bits, tack, etc) will be grounds for DQ.
- If a rider falls from their horse while in the ring, they MUST exit the ring before mounting again.
